

PARTS OF A PLANTS



ROOT

A root is the bottom part of a plant. The root takes in nutrients and water.



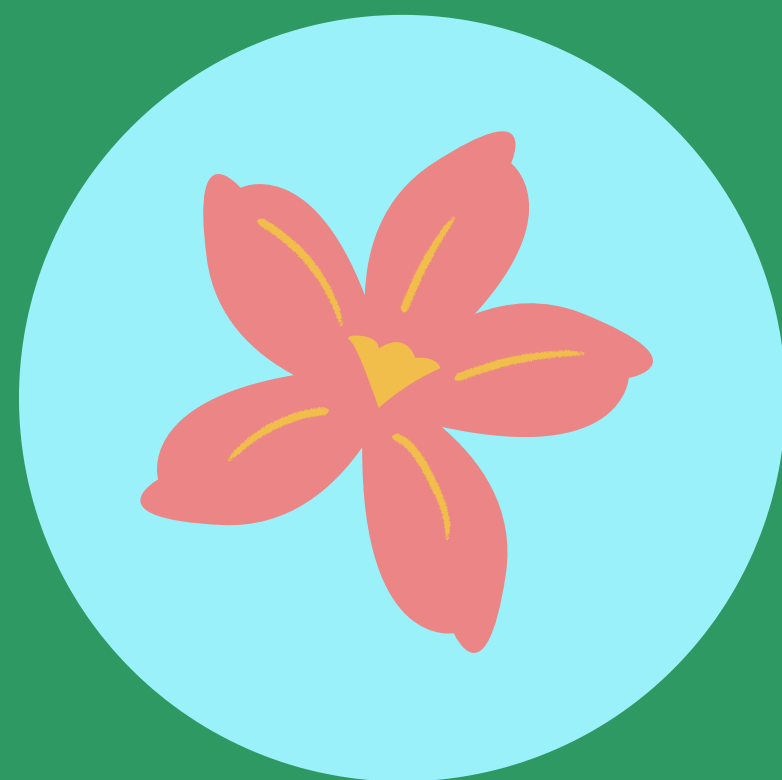
STEM

The stem is the middle part of the plant. The stem gives the plant its shape and brings nutrients from the roots to the leaves.



LEAF

A leaf is a flat part of a plant. It helps to make sunlight into food. The leaf is attached to the stem and branches.



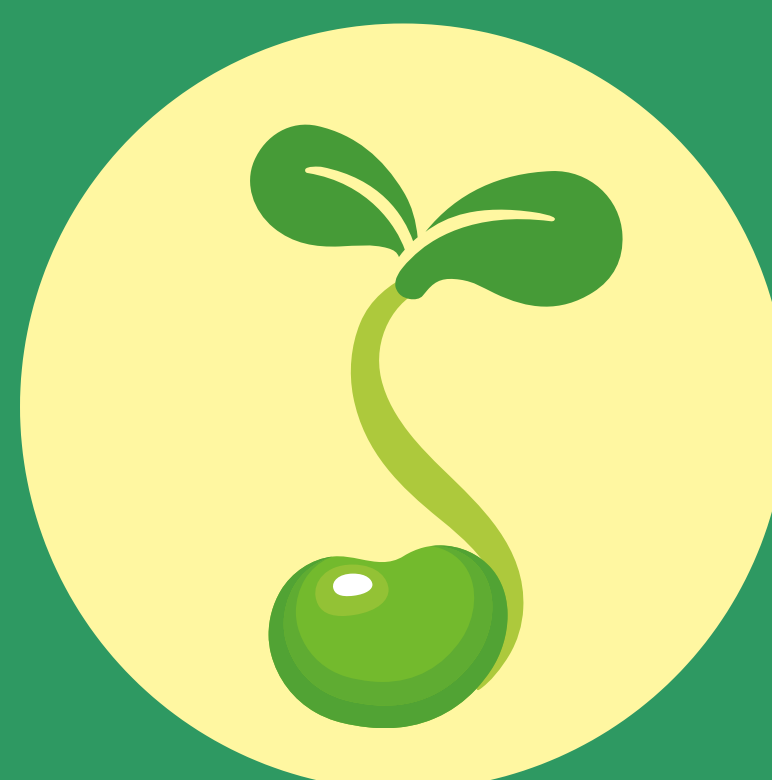
FLOWER

Some plants have flowers. Flowers have many parts. Bees and other insects use part of the flower for food. Flowers help to create new plants!



SEED

A seed has all of the things inside to make a new plant. A seed goes into the ground and with nutrients and water can become a new plant!



SPROUT

A sprout is a young plant. A sprout is a seed in the ground that has started to grow into a plant!
